RECISSION OF MARINE RAILWAY AUTHORITY

Section 1. Recission:

Executive Order No. 3-1978, creating a Marine Railway Authority, is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. Transfer of Records:

All books and records of the Marine Railway are transferred to the Office of Archives and Records Management, subject to use and temporary custody of (1) the Office of Treasury for preparation of a final accounting, processing and payment of bills, and collection of all outstanding receivables, or (2) the Office of Manpower Resources for processing of all personnel changes.

Section 3. Tramway:

The Tramway, and its personnel and budget, is hereby transferred to the Port Administration.


Section 4. Public Notice:

The public is advised that commencing May 1, 1985, all debts owing to the Marine Railway Authority are to be paid to the Revenue Office in Utulei; further, notice to the public is hereby given that the American Samoa Government, effective May 1st, 1985, shall no longer be liable for any activities conducted in or about the premises to be known as the Southwest Marine of Samoa, Inc. Ship Repair Facility, and/or the Ronald Reagan Marine Railway, except as otherwise may be
