TRANSFER OF M/V MATA'ALA

Section 1. TRANSFER.

a. The M/V Mata'ala is transferred from the Department of Public Safety to the Department of Port Administration.

b. The crew of the M/V Mata'ala, unspent funds appropriated to the operation of the vessel during fiscal year 1985, and all materials, equipment and supplies under the jurisdiction of the Department of Public Safety and purchased with funds appropriated to the operation of the vessel are transferred to the Department of Port Administration.

Section 2. FUNCTIONS.

The M/V Mata'ala shall continue to be utilized in connection with the enforcement of the Harbors and Navigation Code, and other laws and the rules related or incidental thereto, and the conduct of search and rescue missions.

Section 3. APPOINTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

Pursuant to Section 46.0201 of the American Samoa Code Annotated, the Commissioner of Public Safety shall appoint the crew members of the M/V Mata'ala as deputy law enforcement officers to exercise the powers and authority of a police officer, including the power of arrest, while they are in the actual performance of their duties as crew members, for the enforcement of the Harbors and Navigation Code, and other laws and the rules related or incidental thereto.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Executive Order is effective immediately.
