EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 04-1993

ADMINISTERING AGENCY FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM GRANTS

Whereas, the American Samoa Government strives to centralize the administration of criminal justice system improvement programs within the territory in order to more effectively plan and implement improvements to the system; and,

Whereas, the American Samoa Government's chief law enforcement officer is the Attorney General, who is mandated to provide support and coordination for criminal justice system programs;

The following criminal justice system improvement programs allocated to the American Samoa Government by the United States Department of Justice and the U.S. Department of the Interior are hereby designated to be administered by the Department of Legal Affairs under the authority of the Attorney General:

1. The Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance and and System Improvement Formula Grant (U.S. Dept. of Justice)
2. The U.S. Department of the Interior Pacific Insular Regional Anti-Substance Abuse Program, PIRAAP, (U.S. Dept. of the Interior)

The existing accounts, Program Coordinator, and the inventory under the administrative funds associated with these grant programs shall be transferred to the Department of Legal Affairs.

This Executive Order is effective April 13th, 1993.
