EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-1995

ELECTRICITY AND WATER CONSERVATION

Section I. - Authority:

This Executive Order is issued under the authority granted to the Governor of American Samoa in Article IV, Section 6, of the American Revised Constitution and Title IV, Chapter 01, Section 011(b), of the American Samoa Code Annotated.

Section II - Purpose:

This Executive Order is issued to further implement ASG policy announced and presented in the Executive Order No. 08-1994. The purpose of this executive order is to reduce electricity consumption and to mandate water conservation at all government facilities.

Section III - Applicability:

This Executive Order applies to all departments, offices, and agencies within the Executive Branch of the American Samoa Government, including ASPA and the ASCC.

Section IV. Prohibition:

The use of any electrical appliances in all government facilities, other than those used in the normal operation any given office, is prohibited. All departments, offices, and agencies shall refrain from using in their offices or facilities the following items:

1. Television, radio, stereo -
2. coffee makers/urns -
3. electrical water coolers -
4. refrigerators, freezers -
5. coin operated coke machines, etc.
6. any other electrical devices which are not related to office functions.

Section V. Exemptions:

1. Agencies exempted from this order are:
2. The School Lunch Program which require freezers, refrigerators, freezers, and certain electrical cooking appliances.
3. School cafeterias which require refrigerators, freezers, and certain electrical cooking appliances.
4. The Hospital, Public Health, and dispensaries which require refrigerators, freezers, and/or certain electrical heating devices.
5. The ASCC cafeteria.
6. Cafeteria at the Correctional Facility in Tafuna.

Section VI. Enforcement:

The director or head of each agency shall be held responsible for the enforcement of this Executive Order.

Section VII. Monitoring:

Close monitoring of this Executive Order shall be made via random and unannounced visitations by a selected team to each office.

Section VIII. Violation:

Strict disciplinary action shall be applied for violation of this order.

Section IX. Disposition:

All government equipment, the use of which are prohibited by this Order, shall be returned immediately to the Procurement Office for disposition according to law.

All items not owned by the ASG shall be returned to their rightful owners and must be removed from the ASG facility immediately.

This Order is effective immediately upon signing and shall remain in effect until further order of the Governor.
