EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 007-1985

TERRITORIAL ADMINISTRATION ON AGING

Section 1. Authority.

This executive order is issued under the authority of Section 6, Article IV, Revised Constitution of American Samoa and the provisions of Section 4.0302(a) American Samoa Code Annotated.

Section 2. Establishment.

This order establishes the Territorial Administration on Aging (TAOA) within the Executive Branch of the American Samoa Government. The physical location of the TAOA will be the Senior Citizens Center in the Village of Pago Pago.

Section 3. Purpose.

The purposes of TAOA will be:

- (a) to provide a single point of contact within the territory for all services to the elderly;
- (b) to administer the Older Americans Act programs;
- (c) to develop and administer the State Plan on Aging;
- (d) to develop a coordinated system with all cognizant agencies for the delivery of supportive services based on needs assessments;
- (e) to serve as an effective and visible advocate for the elderly in American Samoa.

Section 4. Supercedes Previous Orders.

This Executive Order No. 007-1985, supercedes all previous executive orders or general memorandums pertaining to this agency.
