EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 08-1992

ESTABLISHING A WORKING COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP
TERRITORIAL DAMAGE ASSESSMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Territory of American Samoa has been devastated by three hurricanes in the last five years since January 1987, each causing extensive damage to residential structures and widespread damage to real and personal property; and

WHEREAS, three Presidential disaster declarations were declared, triggering the authority of the Disaster Relief Act of 1974 (93-288) as amended by P.L. 100-707 "Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act" for the Territory of American Samoa to receive all Federal Assistance Programs applicable; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a Working Committee from the Department of Public Works, Office of Samoan Affairs, American Samoa Power Authority (ASPA), Office of Communications and the Territorial Emergency Management Coordinating Office (TEMCO) to develop a territorial damage assessment plan,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, PETER TALI COLEMAN, Governor of American Samoa, pursuant to the authority granted under Article IV, Sections 6 and 7 of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa, and Sections 4.0111 and 26.0105(b) and (g) of the American Samoa Code Annotated, do hereby order the Department of Public Works, Office of Samoan Affairs, ASPA, Office of Communications and TEMCO as follows:

1. That each agency designate an individual to be a member of the Working Committee, and that this committee will develop goals and objectives necessary for the damage assessment plan.
2. The TEMCO Manager shall be a member of the committee and is hereby appointed Chairman responsible for the administration and enforcement of the said plan.
