EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15-1992

ESTABLISHMENT OF POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR
ORDERLY TRANSITION FROM THE PRESENT ADMINISTRATION
TO THE NEWLY ELECTED ADMINISTRATION

By the authority vested in the Governor of American Samoa by the Revised Constitution and laws of American Samoa, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Appointment of Transition Coordinator

4.0105 ASCA specifically states that each Governor and Lt. Governors' terms are to terminate on the 3rd of January, and until successors are elected and qualified, to maintain the dignity and respect for the Office of the Governor during the transition period from the present administration to the newly elected administration, a transition coordinator is appointed to allow for the smooth transition from the old administration to the new. Simone Talamaivao, is appointed the transition coordinator and will act as liaison between the present administration and the incoming administration. Any other persons determined to be necessary in helping Mr. Talamaivao to expedite the transition will also be chosen to work with Mr. Talamaivao.

Section 2. Function, Procedures and Policies

The Transition Coordinator will receive all requests for documents and reports, and schedule meetings between American Samoa Government directors or employees and their departments with the transition team from the new administration.

This will ensure the effective and purposeful functioning of the American Samoa Government and meet the needs of the new administration.


Every good faith effort will be made to assist in this transition while allowing the American Samoa Government to operate without interruption or needless interference.
