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EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 011 -2007

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE AMERICAN SAMOA GOVERNMENT LEE AUDITORIUM MAINTENANCE ENTERPRISE FUND AND PROVIDING FOR ITS FUNDING FROM REVENUES GENERATED FROM RENTAL OF THE AUDITORIUM.

Section 1. Authority

This Executive Order is issued under the authority granted to the Governor in Article IV, Sections 6 and 7 of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa, and Section 4.0302 of the American Samoa Code Annotated and Chapter 5 of the American Samoa Administrative Code.

Section 2. Preamble

Whereas, the American Samoa Department of Commerce recently completed a comprehensive renovation of the Lee Auditorium and has opened it for government and non government activities; and

Whereas, the Community Development Block Grant Program, within the US Department of Housing and Urban Development, assisted the American Samoa Government by approving funds for the renovation of the auditorium as well as to purchase furnishings, equipment and supplies; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the American Samoa Government to charge user fees to agencies and other entities wanting to use the auditorium for the purpose of funding the Lee's operations and maintenance, thereby making the operations of the auditorium self-sustaining and ensuring it's existence far into the future.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that this Order is executed to authorize the establishment of the ASG Lee Auditorium Enterprise Fund.

Section 3. Order

(1) The Director of the Department of Commerce, the Attorney General, the Director of Program Planning and Budget Development and the Treasurer of American Samoa shall ensure that the

establishment of the Lee Auditorium Enterprise Fund created by this Order is completed in accordance with statutes and regulations governing such funds within the American Samoa Government.

(2) The authorities noted in the preceding subsection shall plan, develop, implement and enforce standard policies and procedures that shall govern the operation of the fund. These authorities may, from time to time recommend changes to said policies and procedures.


(3) Revenues generated and expended from this enterprise fund shall be for the continued maintenance and operation of such the auditorium under the supervision of the Director of the American Samoa Department of Commerce and all such financial activity shall be duly recorded and reconciled with the Treasurer of American Samoa in accordance with the laws and regulations of the Territory.

(4) The Director of the Department of Commerce shall submit a written report at the end of each fiscal quarter, to the Governor on the status of the fund, and the operations of the auditorium, to include information on the number of entities, government and non-governmental, that have used the auditorium and the types of activities held.

Section 4: Effective Date

This order shall take effect immediately.
