**REORGANIZATION OF THE OFFICES
OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES**

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1 - 1986

Section 1. Authority.

This executive order is issued under the authority of Section 6 of Article IV of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa and Section 4.0302(a) of the American Samoa Code Annotated.

Section 2. Purpose.

The purpose of this executive order is to reorganize the Office of Highway Safety and Office of Motor Vehicles.

Section 3. Consolidation of highway safety, driver and motor vehicle functions.

The functions of the former Office of Highway Safety and Office of Motor Vehicles are consolidated within a single subagency of the Department of Public Safety known as the Office of Highway Safety under the direction and control of the Commissioner. These functions include the coordination of the planning, development, implementation and evaluation of highway and traffic safety programs; providing technical and managerial assistance to other territorial agencies involved with highway and traffic safety programs; administration of federal grants pertaining to highway and traffic safety; operation of the driver education and training programs; and administration of the motor vehicle operator's licensing, motor vehicle registration and motor vehicle inspection laws of American Samoa.

Section 4. Governor's representative for highway safety.

The Governor's Highway Safety Representative for highway safety grants made from the U.S. Department of Transportation will remain in the Governor's immediate staff.

Section 5. Supersession.

This executive order supersedes and cancels executive order No. 14-1985 and all prior executive orders and general memoranda pertaining to the organization and functions of the Offices of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

Section 6. Effective date.

This executive order is effective immediately.
