EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 16 -92

AN ORDER TO CLARIFY THE TRANSFER OF EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF TITLE 20, CHAPTER 03, AMERICAN SAMOA CODE ANNOTATED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PORT ADMINISTRATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY

This executive order is issued under the authority granted in Article IV, Section 5, American Samoa Revised Constitution and Title 4, Chapter 01, Section 0111(b), American Samoa Code Annotated.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to supplement the language in Executive Order No. 12-1991 to make it clear that the Governor intends to transfer complete and exclusive authority over the administration of laws relating to boat operations as set forth in Title 20, Chapter 03, American Samoa Code Annotated, from the Department of Port Administration to the Department of Public Safety.

SECTION 3: TRANSFER OF EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF TITLE 20, CHAPTER 3, AMERICAN SAMOA CODE ANNOTATED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PORT ADMINISTRATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

In addition to the authority and duties set forth in Executive Order No. 12-1991, all authority and duties formerly delegated to the Department of Port Administration in Title 20, Chapter 03, American Samoa Code Annotated, including administrative relamaking authority, are hereby transferred to the Department of Public Safety.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This order is effective immediately.
