EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2-1978:

Section II of the Executive Order of August 24, 1972 is hereby further amended to revise the composition of the Territorial Criminal Justice Planning Agency Supervisory Board as follows:

"II. The Board shall be composed of fifteen (15) members appointed by the Governor. In an effort to provide representation of all related agencies, it shall be the policy to have representatives from the following sources on the Board:

- (a) Office of the Governor
- (b) Office of the Attorney General
- (c) High Court of American Samoa (3 representatives)
- (d) Office of Samoan Affairs
- (e) Police Department, Office of Public Safety
- (f) Correction Division, Office of Public Safety
- (g) Office of Traffic Safety
- (h) Youth Office
- (i) Chairman, Youth Advisory Council
- (j) Public Members, Youth Advisory Council (2 representatives)
- (k) General Public (3 representatives)

Each appointed member shall serve on the Board for a term of one (1) year. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall serve as ex-officio members. The Governor's representative shall serve as Chairman of the Board. Any vacancy shall be filled by the Governor. Members of the Board shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed from agency funds for necessary travel and expenses incurred in conformity with law enforcement activities.

The Board shall have the responsibility of reviewing, approving and maintaining general oversight of the Comprehensive Plan and its implementation."

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2-1978


Section II of the Executive Order of August 24, 1972 is hereby further amended to revise the composition of the Territorial Criminal Justice Planning Agency Supervisory Board as follows:

- (k) General Public (3 representatives)

Each appointed member shall serve on the Board for a term of one (1) year. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall serve as ex-officio members. The Governor's representative shall serve as Chairman of the Board. Any vacancy shall be filled by the Governor. Members of the Board shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed from agency funds for necessary travel and expenses incurred in conformity with law enforcement activities.
