EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17- 1995

Rescission of Executive Order No. 10-95

With the passage of the revenue measure by the Fono, and after signing it today, August 10, 1995, I feel confident that the financial status of the government will be improved.

Therefore, effective August 14, 1995, all employees of ASG will be required to work 40 hours a week. Executive Order #10-95 is hereby rescinded effective August 13, 1995.

While this revenue measure give us temporary relief at this time, it is up to each employee to use prudence in utilizing of government properties that are entrusted to them for use in government services. The government is not out of the woods yet, as far as its finances is concerned. Each employee must be conservative in the use of electricity, water and gasoline.

I ask that each employee must use his employment time wisely to provide the best services not only to your employer, ASG, but also to the public whom we all serve. There should be less time to talk and visit but more time to work. There should be less time to roam and drive around but more time to help out with your duties and responsibilities.
