EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 02 -1993

**TRANSFER OF AUTHORITY TO ADMINISTER,
 MANAGE AND CONTROL GOVERNMENT HOUSING
 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE**

Section 1. Authority

This Executive Order is issued under the authority of Article IV, Section 6 of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa and Section 4.0312(a) of the American Samoa Code Annotated.

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this executive order is to redesignate the Office of the Governor as the agency responsible for the administration, management and control of Government Housing as promulgated under ASCA 12.0502. Whereas, the administration, management and control of Government Housing has been with the Department of Public Works, it is the express purpose of this executive order to facilitate the change over to the governor's office effective March 15, 1993.

Section 3. Transfer of Government Housing

While ASCA 12.0502 established the law which govern the occupation of government housing, there have been no law which provides for the management, control and administration of government housing. This executive order is to give all authority, and power to the Governor's office to administer, manage, and control all properties that are generally known as government housing. This transfer includes but not limited to the transfer of financial management, equipment and inventory, facilities, personnel and personnel files.
