

AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM REVISED ESTIMATED LOCAL REVENUES TO PAY THE SETTLEMENT OF A MEDICAL MALPRACTICE AND WRONGFUL DEATH ACTION AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from fiscal year 1988 revised estimated local revenues the sum of \$25,000 to the Department of Treasury to be used only to pay the settlement of the wrongful death action in the High Court of American Samoa, Civil Action No. 113-87, brought by Iva T. Galo, Peata Galo, Faafetai Galo, Patisepa Galo and Estate of David Galo, against the Government.

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE ACT OF 1900 WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF A MEDICAL MARSHAL SERVICE AND WHICH
MAY BE CITED AS THE MEDICAL MARSHAL SERVICE ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the fund for the year 1900
the sum of \$25,000 to be used for the purpose of carrying out
the provisions of the Act of 1900, which is hereby amended
to read as follows: "The Board of Health of American Samoa, created
by Act No. 113-27, passed by the Legislature of American Samoa, is
authorized to employ and pay the salaries of such persons as it
may deem necessary for the purpose of carrying out the provisions
of this Act."




