

THE TWENTIETH LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA

Third Regular Session

Begun and held at Fagatogo, Tutuila, American Samoa on Monday, the eleventh day of January one thousand nine hundred and eighty eight

AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$50,000 FROM UNBUDGETED AND UNOBLIGATED REVENUE OF FISCAL YEAR 1988 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A WAR MEMORIAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. Appropriation of funds.

There is appropriated from unbudgeted and unobligated funds of fiscal year 1988 the amount of \$50,000 to the Office of the Governor for the purpose of building and designing a permanent war memorial to commemorate the American Samoans who lost their lives serving in the armed forces.


Any funds remaining unexpended and unobligated at the end of fiscal year 1988 shall carry over to fiscal year 1989 and until:


- (a) the completion of the war memorial project, or
- (b) three calendar years from the effective date of this act, whichever occurs first.

Any funds remaining unexpended and unobligated at the end of the period authorized by this act revert to the general fund and may not be expended or obligated without subsequent appropriation by the Legislature.

Sec 2. Design, location and inscription.

The memorial shall be erected in front of the Legislature building as a wall inscribed with the name, the branch of service, and date of death of each American Samoan who has died in any armed conflict while serving the United States armed forces since 1900.
