BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

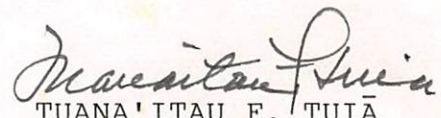
Section 1. There is created a new section 11.1003.1 which
reads:

"11.1003.1 Exemption for specially-equipped motor vehicles.

(a) Any motor vehicle which has been specially equipped
and is imported by and for the personal use of a severely dis-
abled individual, is exempt from the excise tax on the impor-
tation of a motor vehicle."
