AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE INCOME EARNED ON THE INVESTMENT OF THE AMERICAN SAMOA COMMUNITY COLLEGE LAND GRANT ENDOWMENT FUND TO PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED UNDER THE SMITH LEVER, HATCH, AND MORRILL NELSON ACTS.

PREAMBLE:


This act is effective upon passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor due to the emergency need to timely provide funds for the operations of the land grant program.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. There is appropriated the sum of \$100,000 from the income earned on the investment of the American Samoa Community College Land Grant Endowment Fund to the American Samoa Community College. The college shall use the funds solely to provide the match required under the Smith Lever, Hatch, and Morrill Nelson Acts to receive federal funds.


Any unexpended funds at the close of fiscal year 1988 revert to the American Samoa Community College Land Grant Endowment Fund and may not be expended until further appropriation by the Legislature.

Sec 2. This act is effective immediately upon passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor due to the emergency need to timely provide funds for the operations of the land grant program.


