THE TWENTIETH LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA

Second Regular Session

Begun and held at Fagatogo, Tutuila, American Samoa on Monday, the thirteenth day of July one thousand nine hundred and eighty seven

AN ACT MAKING DISTRICT, COUNTY, AND VILLAGE OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES AND NON-CAREER SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE LEGISLATURE ELIGIBLE AS MEMBERS OF THE AMERICAN SAMOA GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT FUND; AMENDING SECTION 7.1421.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Seciton 1. 7.1421 is amended to read:

"7.1421 Persons ineligible for membership.

The following employees are not eligible for membership in the fund:

- (1) a person occupying a position whose duties will not permit service for more than 50 days a year;
- (2) a person whose services are compensated on a fee basis;
- (3) an independent contractor;
- (4) a person whose employment is purely temporary, seasonal, intermittent, part-time, or only for a specific project;
- (5) an employee who is a member of any other retirement system except the military, and who is accruing creditable service in that system, unless the employee terminates his membership in the other system;
- (6) an employee over 70 years of age;
- (7) an employee of the government for a definite or fixed term; however, notwithstanding the foregoing, judges, district, county and village officials and employees, and non-career service employees of the Legislature, other than contract employees are eligible for membership."
