AN ACT APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$721,000 TO FUND THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER BUILDING IN TAFUNA.

Preamble:

WHEREAS, it is essential to establish a central location for the senior citizen community in American Samoa to provide services and hold functions for their health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, such a facility will be aimed at providing said services; and

WHEREAS, the previous facilities were unable to meet the needs of senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, a new facility will better provide for the needs of the community and assist the Territorial Administration on Aging to accomplish their mission; and

WHEREAS, the surplus from 2019 can be used to effectively assist in the construction of this new facility.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. Appropriation of revenue.

There is appropriated the sum of seven hundred and twenty-one thousand dollars (\$721,000) to construct the Senior Citizen Center building in Tafuna. The source of these funds shall be from the fiscal year surplus from 2019. These funds are collected on an accrual basis and shall be distributed when they are collected and made available.

Sec 2. Effective date.

This Act shall become effective sixty (60) days after passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor.
