SHORTFALL RECTIFICATION PROGRAM  
SUSPENSION OF THE GOVERNMENT WORK WEEK RESTRICTIONS

While there remains a continuing need for cost containment and strict fiscal controls in the operations of the American Samoa Government, the measures in place over the past 6 months have enabled the Government to cope with the fiscal situation to the point of permitting Government employees to return to work week of 40 regular hours.

Therefore, by the authority vested in the Governor of American Samoa by the Revised Constitution and laws of American Samoa, it is hereby ordered:

1. Suspension of the Government work week restrictions.

Effective September 25, 1983, Section 1 of Executive Order No. 6-1983 is suspended until further notice, and all Government employees are returned to a work week of 40 hours.
