REORGANIZATION OF DRIVER, MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC SAFETY FUNCTIONS

Section 1. Authority

This executive order is issued under the authority of Section 6 of Article IV of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa and Section 202(a) of Title 3 of the American Samoa Code.

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this executive order is to reorganize driver, motor vehicle and traffic safety functions and programs within the Department of Public Safety.

Section 3. Consolidation of driver, motor vehicle and traffic safety functions

The functions of the Office of Traffic Safety and Office of Motor Vehicles are consolidated within a single subagency of the Department of Public Safety. These functions include the coordination of the planning, development, implementation and evaluation of highway and traffic safety programs; providing technical and managerial assistance to other territorial agencies involved with highway and traffic safety programs; administration of federal grants pertaining to highway and traffic safety; operation of the driver education and training program; and administration of the motor vehicle operator's licensing, motor vehicle registration and motor vehicle inspection laws of American Samoa.

Section 4. Amendment of Executive Order 3-1979

Section 3 of Executive Order 3-1979 is amended to read:

"Section 3. Establishment

The Office of Traffic Safety is established within the Department of Public Safety."

In all other respects, Executive Order 3-1979 is affirmed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 5. Governor's representative for traffic safety


The position of Governor's Highway Safety Representative for highway safety grants made under the federal Highway Safety Act of 1966, as amended, and Surface Transportation Act of 1978, as amended, will remain on the Governor's immediate staff. The person in charge of the consolidated driver, motor vehicle and traffic

safety functions and programs is authorized to deal directly with the Governor's Representative on all matters pertaining to these federal grants.
